In the Dynamic Energetic Healing® model, Brockman synthesizes three different healing modalities: energy psychology, core shamanic practices and process-oriented psychology.

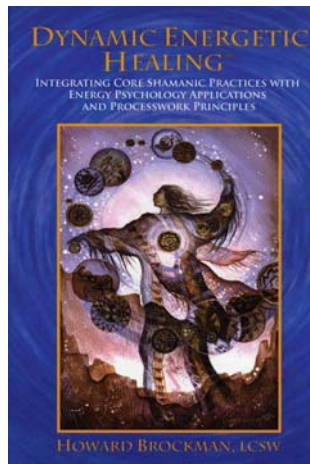
